Terms & Conditions

General

- All entrants must have a signed permission letter from a parent or guardian in order to be accepted into the competition. Concept Hair will provide a copy of the letter to the school.
- All application forms must be submitted by a teacher or representative from the school and they must truthfully and accurately complete all required fields. If you supply or have supplied any untruthful, inaccurate or misleading details and/or information and/or have failed to abide by the Rules or Brief the participant may be disqualified.
- After submission, the entrant cannot be changed unless the organisers agree. This will be determined at Concept Hair's sole discretion.
